Dear Parents/Guardians:

In support of Massachusetts Veterans and Military families, the state has adopted the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military (M.I.C.3). The adoption of this compact ensures constant treatment of military children entering and attending the Abington Public Schools.

The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education has asked the Abington Public Schools to help identify qualifying students and families by collecting and reporting the information below:

Your child may be eligible for these benefits if your family meets one or more of the following criteria:

- Active duty members of the uniformed services
- National Guard and Reserve on active duty orders;
- Members or veterans who are medically discharged or retired within one year
- Members who die on active duty within one year

If you believe your family meets the aforementioned criteria please complete and return this form to the main office of your child's school by Monday, June 16, 2014.
