IDENTICAL TWINS: When one zygote splits in half

FRATERNAL TWINS: Two eggs are fertilized by two different sperm

SIAMESE (CONJOINED) TWINS: A zygote doesn't split all the way (ALWAYS the same sex!!)

TERMS TO KNOW:

AMNIOTIC SAC: sac filled with fluid where baby grows

UMBILICAL CORD: connects baby to placenta

PLACENTA: organ that nourishes the baby

OBSTETRICIAN: Doctor who specializes in delivering babies

THINGS TO AVOID DURING PREGNANCY:

- 1. Drugs- baby could be addicted
- 2. Alcohol- fetal alcohol syndrome
- 3. Cigarettes- low birth weight
- 4. X-rays- radiation can cause abnormalities
- 5. Aspirin- can cause baby's organs to bleed and baby may die

CALCULATING A DUE DATE: add nine months and one week to the date of her last period ex: period was June 12, 2018 + 9 months =March 12 + 7 days = March 19, 2019

WEIGHT GAIN: pregnant women should gain 25-30 pounds
